

MUSEUM RULES

Artefacts	Do not touch artworks.
Handbags	These must be left in the lockers if they are larger than A4 size (approx. 20 x 30cm).
Luggage	Backpacks, schoolbags, cases and all bulky objects must be left in the lockers.
Coats and jackets	You may wear your coat or jacket inside the museum but do not carry it over your arm.
Umbrellas and walking sticks	Umbrellas must be left in the appropriate umbrella stand at the entrance. Only walking sticks with a protective rubber tip are allowed inside the museum.
Photos/films	It is forbidden to take photographs or film inside the museum. Cameras must be left in the cloakroom lockers.
Mobile phones	It is forbidden to use your mobile phone either to phone or to take pictures.
Young visitors	Children must be accompanied by an adult in the exhibition areas. Baby-buggies are available at the Reception.
Animals	All animals except guide-dogs for the blind are forbidden within the museum area.
Food and drink	All food and drink is strictly forbidden inside the museum, exceptional cases have to be announced at the Reception.
Smoking	Smoking is strictly forbidden inside the museum.

Thank you for complying with these Museum Rules as well as with the instructions given by our surveillance staff who is responsible for the safety of the artworks on view in the museum galleries.
